Construction materials may be stored temporarily in the corridor during the workday, as long as the minimum prescribed clear corridor width is maintained. Construction materials shall not remain in the ...

Alcoves in corridors can be used for storage as long as the stored items do not project into the corridor. Dead-end corridors may be used for storage or sitting areas as long as it occupies ...
