

What is the African single Electricity Market (afsem)?

On June 3, 2021, The African Union officially launched the African Single Electricity Market (AfSEM). This marked the commencement of an electricity market that connected the power supply infrastructure of the Union's 55 member countries. The goal is the development of one continuous efficient and affordable electricity market across the continent.

Which energy sources dominate energy consumption in Africa in 2024?

In 2024, biofuels and wastes continue to dominate energy consumption in Africa, accounting for 54.41% of total final energy consumption. This reflects the widespread use of traditional biomass in many countries, highlighting the urgency to diversify energy sources and modernize bioenergy consumption on the continent.

What is Africa's energy potential?

Africa has huge renewable energy generation potential. According to the Global Solar Atlas, the continent's average solar energy potential is 4.51 kWh/kWp/day, the highest of any region globally. Also, about 90% of the continent's hydropower potential remains unexploited-- the largest proportion of untapped capacity globally.

How has energy changed in Africa compared to 2000?

Compared to the year 2000, there has been a notable increase in electricity production from renewable sources, including solar and wind, marking a strong commitment to the energy transition in Africa. Diversification of energy sources is also evident with the growth in natural gas production, while crude oil production shows a declining trend.
