Why are data centers a problem in Seoul?

In Seoul metropolitan area, the demand for data centers is surging, but power supply is limited, making it increasingly challenging to secure and allocate electricity. In central Seoul, securing data center sites with available power has become an even greater challenge.

Can a data center server rack be powered by a DC power supply?

Most data center server racks are not currently powered this way, but with the advent of servers on the market that can operate with either AC or DC, it is possible to use the DC powering approach, thus eliminating extra power conversion steps and losses.

Do data centers use AC or DC power?

Data centers adopted many things from telecoms, most notably the ubiquitous 19-inch rack, which was standardized by AT&T way back in 1922. Now, those racks hold electronic systems whose guts - the chips inside the servers - fundamentally all run on DC power. But data centers distribute power by AC.
