How much does it cost to make a call to Naypyidaw?

In Naypyidaw, local calls are charged MMK 100 or EUR0.10 per minute and international calls are EUR5 per minute. All hotel rooms have fixed telephone lines, and there are also several phone booths scattered across the city and some shops where you can make calls.

Does Naypyidaw have a reliable electricity supply?

Naypyidaw is the only city in Myanmar with a reliable 24-hour electric service. Expats staying in hotels do not need to worry about their utilities as it is included in their accommodation. However, those living in residential areas or outside the capital may need to pay for their power bill since it might not be included in the rental cost.

Why is mobile service banned in Naypyidaw?

Mobile service was initially banned in Naypyidaw because of security reasons. Government officials, employees, and soldiers used walkie-talkies for communication. However, in 2009, the capital allowed its residents to use their mobile phones to enhance its services further to its people and foreign visitors.

Does Naypyidaw offer free WiFi?

All hotels in Naypyidaw offer free WiFi access.

unit or BBU) and each base station can serve one or more radios.

LTE Base station manufacturers and telecom service providers install base stations to provide cellular mobile and internet services to wireless mobile and internet users across the globe.
