



Vientiane electric grid

The Laos-China 500kV interconnection project has been officially launched in the Lao capital, Vientiane.

The overnight strikes hit high-voltage transmission lines that are used to transmit electricity nationwide and that form the backbone of Ukraine's power grid, as well as power plants and ...

On November 13, 2017, China Development and the Government of Laos signed a \$215 million buyer's credit loan agreement for the Vientiane Power Grid Modernization Project.

On 26 February, Laos launched the Lao-China 500-kilovolt Interconnection Project with a ceremony in Vientiane Capital. This project is part of a broader effort to enhance regional energy integration.
